The questions will be drawn from those sources.

The students are competing as a team. All pre-registered students will compete on Thursday, May 6, 2010 against a team from the media. No last minute registrations are allowed. Famous Critic Dusty Saunders will be the Interlocutor, asking questions of educational merit. We will feature the Students and their literary acumen in an open session. A Celebrity Panel will be asked difficult questions, to show their superior acquaintance with the Bard. Student winners will be the team on each of the three levels who score the most points. Challenge Bowl Awards will be distributed. Only three students for your team may answer questions, and only those three students may participate. You may have two alternates in case of absence Festival Day. We will again use the old classic configuration for The Challenge Bowl. Anyone calling out answers from non-team members or audience will cause immediate cancellation of the event and the dispersal of the audience. The Challenge Bowl will then be continued without an Audience.

Make sure information is complete for the students, as participants may be contacted. Spell names correctly as certificates are made with the spelling you provide on the form.

Each participating team will submit ten questions from the two categories above. Please send or E-mail to: Joe Craft, 1330 Fox St. by March 1st, 2010. Sample questions will be sent to schools without answers for your practice. Questions will not necessarily appear in the actual Challenge Bowl.

Return this form to Joe Craft at Fox St, 2nd Floor South by Monday, March 1st, 2010, with your other forms due that day. Alternates may not compete unless the primary student is absent. Inform **GuildMasters** if you have substitutes. You may not have five members competing on your team. Alternates must sit in the audience, and not participate in any way, or call out the answers. This includes all Audience members.
